
## Downtown Grocery bus trips:

#### **PAST DUE RENT?**

All COVID-19 rent moratoriums have ended and now landlords like SHRA are collecting late rent. Part of the process are 30-Day and 15-day notices.

If you receive one of these notices you should set up a meeting with your manager and find out what options are available to you. You may be

eligible for a repayment agreement. If you are, they will set up a monthly payment addition to your rent to clear up the balance.

If you sign up with the Rent+ program regular an-time payments will help build a good credit history and increase your credit score.

**Rent Café** Provides an easy way to pay your rent each

month. Go online to www.shra.org and click on the [Pay Rent] box. You can pay directly from you checking account, an ATM card, or a credit card. The software will reply with a receipt with in a few hours. You may also set up automatic payments for each month. Rent Café is now available to most SHRA tenants.



#### SHRA Holiday Schedule & Emergency Maintenance

This year, all SHRA offices will be closed for the holidays and winter break from December 22, 2023-January 1st, 2024. please note that all offices will be open in person by APPOINTMENT ONLY on Friday, December 22nd from 8am-12pm.

SHRA offices will resume normal operations on Tuesday, January 2, 2024 at 8:00am.

During the office closures, there will be on-call maintenance technicians available for emergency issues only.

#### **ALWAYS CALL 911 FOR LIFE** THREATENING EMERGENCIES

PLAN AHEAD. Make sure you have an extra apartment key, a back-up plan for cooking and other holiday festivities, just in case you experience a maintenance issue that is not considered an emergency. We would like to remind you that we do not respond to lock-outs.

For emergency maintenance requests, please call 916-449-1288. Maintenance emergencies include:

- No Water
- No Power
- Smoke Detector
- No Heat (Below 40 degrees)
- Toilet Clogged (1 toilet in unit)
- Sink Overflow
- **Toilet Overflow**
- Carbon Monoxide Detector (Call PG&E first)
- No Gas or Gas smell (Call PG&E first)

If you falsely report an after-hours emergency, you will be charged a trip -charge AND A 2-hour minimum maintenance fee.

# Do you use your telephone for Zoom meetings?

Here are a few helpful tips to make it go easier for you joining the meetings:

#### Step 1

You will need to call: 669-444-9171 OR 669-900-9128 OR 253-205-0468 OR 253-215-8782 AND follow the verbal instructions.

#### Step 2

Enter the meeting ID you wish to join followed by the # key.

#### Step 3

You will be asked to enter your participant ID. — If you do not know your participant ID, simply press the # key

#### Step 4

You have now joined the Zoom meeting. To Mute/Unmute yourself, press \*6. To Raise/Lower your hand press \*9

TIP: write down the meeting number and participant ID large enough to see before you call.
